The Fire District currently provides services to the Towns of Frederick and Firestone, as well as several areas of unincorporated Weld County. Currently, the District provides services to approximately 36 square miles with a population over 38,000 residents.

The District works closely with the towns to ensure all resident and community needs are met when it comes to emergency services. The District currently employs 84 full-time staff.



THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The Fire Prevention Specialist will work under the supervision and direction of the Fire District's command structure and reports directly to the Assistant Chief of Planning. The Fire Prevention Specialist will be responsible for a variety of technical functions including fire and life safety inspections, plan reviews, origin and cause investigations, and general community risk reduction services within the District.

The Frederick-Firestone Fire District is continuously looking for ways to improve service while upholding our mission. The ideal candidate will possess strong communication skills, be detail-oriented in nature, and have a strong work ethic that embodies the District's mission, vision, and values.

DUTIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Ability to conduct the review and application of the fire and life safety code to facilitate uniform and consistent application within the District jurisdiction.
- Ability to perform target hazard business inspections for commercial and industrial properties.
- Assist in plan reviews for fire suppression and alarm systems for all types of occupancies.
- Capability to assist in determining the origin and cause of fire investigations, as well as prepare reports and documents necessary for submitting a fire investigation case.

CORE QUALIFICATIONS:

- Associate Degree in related field required. Highly preferred Bachelor's Degree.
- Minimum five (5) years of experience in fire and/or emergency service field.
- Must possess minimum certifications of Fire investigation Technician, EMT-B and CPR, Hazmat Operations, and Firefighter II with Fire Officer I preferred.
- Must hold or obtain Fire Code Inspector I within six (6) months; State of Colorado Fire School Inspector II and Junior Firesetter Level I within one (1) year; and Colorado Fire Inspector III-Plans Examiner certification and Colorado Fire Inspector Certification within two (2) years of appointment.
- Strong communication skills, public relations skills, and customer service skills.
